Village of De Soto Ordinance No.9

ENTERTAINMENT AND DANCING

<u>SECTION 1</u>: It shall be unlawful within the Village of DeSoto for any tavern, bar, inn, saloon. Nightclub, private club or club of any kind restaurant, or any business place of any kind:

To hire or employ, or have, or to allow in their, his/her place of business in any manner for the purpose of entertainment, amusement, recreation, or for the soliciting or enticing, of patrons or customers in any manner:

Any female, male or person, who's his or her purpose, is for entertainment, amusement, recreation or art in the nude, semi-nude, or nude in any manner.

Any entertainment, dance, dances, or dancers commonly referred to as GoGo Girls, South Sea dancers or dances, Apache dancers or dances, African dancers or dances, Leg dancers or dances, Body dancers or dances or entertainment that in any wav resembles in any matter, any of the above said dancers, dances or entertainment.

SECTION 2: MOVIES, FILMS OR PICTURES.

It shall be unlawful within the Village of De Soto to show in any manner, any movie, film, slides, or pictures in any nature in any of the business places as so named in SECTION 1. That in any manner or style resembles any part of the restricted dancers dances and entertainment so named in SECTION 1, or any moving picture, film or pictures of any kind that are of the nude, semi-nude, lewd, obscene or indecent.

Penalty for violation of Ordinance #9 Section No. 1 and 2 shall be fined not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and cost, or may have their tavern license suspended for not more than ten (10) days or both for the first offense and not more than thirty (30) days or both for the second offense.
