Village Of De Soto Ordinance No.12

PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF OPEN INTOXICANTS AND FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC

<u>SECTION 1</u>: No person shall be in possession of any intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverage in an open container while in or upon any public street, alley, sidewalk, public parking lot or any public way.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: No person shall be in possession of any intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverage in an open container while in or upon any retail business establishment, professional office, gasoline service station, manufacturing plant or similar business generally open to the public unless such possession shall be with the permission of the owner, occupant, or person in charge of such premises.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: All intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages served by the glass or in open containers in licensed premises shall be consumed on the licensed premises where served and shall not be removed from such premises.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: No licensee of premises licensed for the consumption on such premises of intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages, his employees or agents, shall permit any person to remove from such premises in an open container or by the glass, intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages purchased on such premises.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) plus costs.
