  Extended Aeration Oxidation Ditch = 3.6 million
  Conventional Activated Sludge = 3.5 million
  Sequencing Batch Reactor = 3.8 million

Funding available: CDBG Public Facility Grant = 1 million Clean Water Fund 45% grant = 1.4 million Loan = 1.5 million for 20 years at 1.287 %
