2. The village board will take input from the public as to discuss the proposed Wastewater Treatment Facility Planning.
3. Donna Loutsch and Kim Bohnenkamp were present for public input.
4. James Makepeace discussed the engineer's report on the sewer plant and the proposed facility plan. The current sewer plant has been in existence since 1965.
Aerated lagoon = 4.6 million
Extended Aeration Oxidation Ditch = 3.6 million
Conventional Activated Sludge = 3.5 million
Sequencing Batch Reactor = 3.8 million

Funding available:

CDBG Public Facility Grant = 1 million

Clean Water Fund 45% grant = 1.4 million

Loan = 1.5 million for 20 years at 1.287 %
