## De Soto Village Board Public Hearing Wastewater Treatment Facility Planning

- 1. The De Soto Village Board held their public hearing on Tuesday, July 2, 2024 at the De Soto Village Hall.
- 2. Village President Timothy Gillespie started the public hearing at 6:45 p.m. with roll call as follows: Timothy Gillespie-present, Scott DuCharme-present and Mitchell Schiffer-present. Joel Greiner, Michael Ryan & James Makepeace attending. Carrie Brudos-clerk
- 2. The village board will take input from the public as to discuss the proposed Wastewater Treatment Facility Planning.
- 3. There was no one present for public input.
- 4. James Makepeace discussed the engineer's report on the sewer plant and the proposed facility plan. The current sewer plant has been in existence since 1965. Funding has gone from 45% to 25% for the Clean Water Fund grant, due to an error made by the Census Bureau. As a result, the village will have to take out an additional \$500,000 for a loan. The interest rate also went from 1.287 % to 2.255%.

Loan = 1.154,150 million for 20 years at 1.287 % (previous rate)

Loan = 1,664,750 million for 20 years at 2.255%
